The Supplementary Term End Examinations for the failed final year students of UG and PG courses and PG Diploma courses during April / May, 2017 are to be held during June, 2017 and the examination application forms for the same will be issued to the respective departments on 22.5.2017. Eligible students for applying supplementary examination:

- Outgoing students who passed in all subjects in final semester and have arrear in *only one subject* in any one of the previous semesters (i.e. semesters I through V) *or the failed theory subjects of their final semester only*.
- Failed out gone students (students admitted from 2004 academic year onwards) with arrear in *only one subject* in *any* of the semesters (semesters I through VI).
